Nominations brief: Once again the organisers of this prestigious award are seeking nominations. First presented in 1985, the Ambassador of the Year Award was created to encourage the promotion of Guernsey outside the island. The Award, which is not linked to tourism, should have the widest possible appeal and application. Nominations may be made by individuals or organisations and should be accompanied by a brief description of the reasons for nomination, which should only relate to 2010. There is no limit on nominations except that the Award will not normally be presented to any person or to any group whose full or part-time profession is to promote the island. In the past, winners have been involved in the arts, music, sport, horticulture and even ornithology.

The official definition for nomination reads: "For people who have brought credit and recognition to Guernsey during 2010". Previous winners include: Eric Snell, Stuart Falla MBE, The Fitness Factory Rowing Team, The Chefs Circle, World Champion racing driver Andy Priaulx, Jamie and Vanessa Le Tissier and in 2007 Dame Mary Perkins, Founder of The Specsavers Group.
